

Natural Law vs. Man's Law

Natural law is the inherent, unchangeable, immutable law of the universe. Natural Law is also known as God's Law, Moral Law, Spiritual Law, and Universal Law. It is based on knowledge, wisdom, and living in a state of harmony with the universe. It is based on the simple principle of **do no harm to another**. All harm is some form of theft, this includes stealing physical property to taking someone's life. **Example:** Stealing from another is wrong because it violates the inherent God-given rights of another. It is not wrong simply because of any man-made "law". It is inherently wrong because it infringes on another's rights and **the violator will always be subject to the karmic consequences of the universe no matter who you are or where you live.** You never "get away" with anything.

Man's law is based on moral relativism, dogma, and artificial social constructs that vary from place to place and time periods in history. **Example:** J-walking is considered wrong and illegal but only because of the dogmatic beliefs of the culture. This law can be changed any time and then a wrong suddenly becomes a right. It also may be perfectly legal or "right" in another country. This is the inherent problem with man's law. **If an action is truly wrong (immoral), it is ALWAYS WRONG, no matter what and no matter where.**

The Illusion of Authority

We give authority to many individuals around us, including police, military, government, and religious leaders. Our societal belief in authority directly leads to a state of unconscious "following" of orders without examining whether what we are doing is right or wrong. **Authority leads to unchecked power and immorality without fail.** Authority in and of itself is a violation of Natural Law. Authority presumes one person can control another and take away their God-given rights and freedom. This will always lead to the destruction of the human spirit, immorality, human slavery and societal degradation.

Authority is an illusion because they do not inherently have authority over you, you are granting them authority over you. We are doing this collectively every day as a society, but we don't have to. We can stop this collectively at any time we choose. **We can end our own slavery!** As a collective, we can move to a system of voluntaryism where everyone's rights are respected. This is a foundational principle to building real community that is rooted in harmony, peace, and love. The 7 Deadly Sins

The real 7 deadly sins are not the vices that we are taught growing up. They are actually based on violations of Natural Law. Immorality is an act that violates one of these 7 deadly sins. If it does not violate one of these 7 deadly sins, it is not immoral. Many actions and lifestyles that are deemed “immoral” by certain cultures, societies, and people are based merely on preference, convenience, and fear (moral relativism) and have nothing to do with true objective morality which never changes (right vs wrong action).

The 7 Deadly Sins are all forms of stealing:

- Murder (stealing a life, does not include self-defense)
- Assault (stealing someone's physical well-being, does not include self-defense)
- Rape (stealing sexual contact)
- Theft of property (stealing physical or intellectual property from another)
- Trespass (stealing privacy from another)
- Coercion (stealing free will from another)
- Lying (stealing someone's ability to make informed decisions)

The Law of Freedom

As Morality increases, Freedom increases. As Morality declines, Freedom declines.

Another way of stating this Law would be to say that the presence of Truth and Morality in the lives of the people of any given society is inversely proportional to the presence of Tyranny and Slavery in that society.

- The term "my truth" is a new age term designed to lead individuals to **moral relativism**.
- Moral relativism (right and wrong changing depending on circumstances while denying obvious objective Truths/facts) is destructive to the individual and the collective. **Example:** Believing a soldier murdering someone is okay, but a citizen murdering someone is illegal and wrong. If murder is wrong, it is always wrong unless it is in self-defense.

The Necessity of UnLearning

We all know and realize the great importance of learning. Real Learning Is More Than Memorization...It Is Embodiment Of The New Information but we often forget that unlearning is just as important.

UnLearning starts with questioning EVERYTHING... You Have To Question Everything & Be Willing To Accept The Answers (even if you really, really don't like them). It is crucial to be able to admit when you are wrong, have been tricked, or are a victim of programming. When you accept this, then you have a point that you can move forward from in Truth and Light.
